Any tender received after the due date & time will be rejected / returned to the sender unopened. **The tenders will be received through Regd. Post / Speed Post/ Courier only.**
2. Pre-bid conference shall be held in the office chamber of the C.D.M.& PHO NAYAGARH on dated **18.06.2018 at 11 A.M.** The prospective bidders may attend and clarify any doubts on the terms and conditions of the bid document.
3. The bidder(s) are to submit their tenders in separate sealed covered envelopes for technical bid and financial bid by superscribing Cover “A” (Technical Bid) & Cover “B” (Price Bid) and both the covers should be put into a third Cover, which should be superscribed as **“Tender for the supply of DRUGS CONSUMABLES to the C.D.M.& PHO,NAYAGARH”**. Reference No. C.D.M.& PHO (01/01.06.2018).
4. The Sealed tenders “Cover-A” (Technical Bid) submitted by the tenderers will be opened by the C.D.M.& PHO, NAYAGARH in the office chamber of the C.D.M.& PHO, NAYAGARH at **11 A.M. on dated 03.07.2018.** The tenderers or their duly authorized representatives are allowed to be present during the opening of the tenders if they so like.
5. 6. The tender paper should be clearly type only in English and rates should be clearly visible. Hand written tender paper will be rejected.
7. Delivery of the drugs and consumables should be FOR destination i.e. O/o CDMO, Nayagarh.
8. The rates should be mentioned as rate with GST and all other taxes, transport cost in the prescribed proforma separately.
9. The undersigned / Committee is not bound to accept the lowest tender rate considering the technical and quality aspect.
10. The unit of items and name of the manufacture should be mentioned clearly.
11. The rate of present tender will be valid up to 1 year or inviting of next tender whichever is earlier.
12. If any information or documents furnished by the tender are found to be incorrect or misleading at any stage the tender will be rejected.

13. The interested firm should deposit **RS, 35,000/- (Rupees Thirty five thousand) only through Bank Draft in favour of CENTRAL DRUG HOUSE, NAYAGARH** towards Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) with the tender paper which will be refunded after finalization of tender process except the selected bidder. 14. The authority / committee reserve the full right to accept in full or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.
15. Tender shall be either a manufacture of loan licensee or a direct importer.
  - a) In case of manufacture or loan licensee (for items coming under drugs), it shall have valid manufacturing drug license or valid renewal drug license issued by the State License Approving Authority (where applicable). If the validity of drug license expires on the date of bid opening, validity certificate/renewal certificate from licensing authority will have to submit.
  - b) In case of importer, it should have a valid import license and product Registration certificate issued by the Drug Controller General of India (for items coming under drugs) and manufacture should authorized the importer to deal business in India.
  - c) Manufacturing/ Import license from the relevant issuing authority in India (for items not coming under drugs).
16. For all Category items, Manufactures, authorized distributors are eligible to participate in the tender.
  - a) In case of manufacture (for items coming under drugs), it shall have valid GMP certificate as per Revised Schedule M of Drugs and Cosmetics Rule 1945 (by and large GMP Certificate will not be accepted/COPP (Certificate of Pharmaceutical Products) certificate issued by the concerned licensing authority.
  - b) In case of importer (for items coming under drugs), WHO GMP (of Manufacture) shall be submitted.
17. Each Strip/ Box/ bottle/Amp./ Vial etc shall bear the seal of the manufacturer and month of Manufacturing, month of expiry and Batch No. and labelling of "ODISHA GOVT. SUPPLY- NOT FOR SALE"
18. The approved supplier (tenderer) shall have the direct responsibility for supply of stock and who shall only be entitled to raise the bill against such supply. Payments will be made only in favour of the approved supplier (tendered)

### **PRICE:**

Only the price quoted by the suppliers in his/their financial proposal will be the price for payment and no other price escalation will be allowed at no circumstances.

### **TERMS FOR PAYMENT:**

- A. The payments shall be made by purchaser in Indian currencies. No advance payment towards cost of drugs will be made to the tenderer.
- B. Before release of payment the supplier has to submit the signed agreement.

### **GOVERNING LANGUAGE:**

The contract shall be written in English language. English language version of the contract shall govern its interpretation. All correspondences and other documents pertaining in the contract which are exchanged by the parties shall be written in English.

### **DELIVERY OF DOCUMENT**

Four (4) copies of the supplier invoice/bills showing purchase order number, goods description, quantity, unit price, total amount with stock entry certificate by the consignee.

### **PACKAGING:**

The supplier shall provide such packaging of the goods as is required to prevent their damage or deterioration during transit to their final destination. The packaging shall be sufficient to withstand without limitation rough handling during transit and exposure to extreme temperature, salt and precipitation during transit and upon storage. All primary packaging containers which come in contact with the item should strictly protect the quality and integrity of the drugs. Packaging case size and weights should be taken into consideration in case of remoteness of final destination and the absence of heavy handling facilities at all points in transit.

The packaging marketing shall show the description of quantity of contents, the name of the consignee and address, the gross weight of the packaging, the name of the supplier with a distinctive number of marks sufficient for purposes of identification, Each package shall Contain:

- i. A packaging note quoting the name of the purchaser
- ii. The number and date of order
- iii. Nomenclature of the goods
- iv. Name and address of the consignee
- v. Name and address of the supplier

## **TERMS OF CONTRACT**

The CDM&PHO NAYAGARH will be at liberty to terminate without assigning any reason the contract either wholly or in part. The tenderers will not be entitled to any compensation whatsoever in such terminations.

### **PENALTIES:**

If the successful tenderer fails to execute the agreement and/ or deposit the required security within the time specified or withdraws his tender after acceptance of his tender owing to any other reasons, he is unable to undertake the contract, his contract will be cancelled and the earnest Money deposited by him along with his tender shall stand forfeited and he will also be liable for all damages sustained by the purchaser by reasons of such breach, such as failure to supply including the liability to pay any difference between the prices accepted by him and those ultimately paid for the procurement of the articles concerned. Such damages shall be assessed by the purchaser, whose decision is final and binding in the matter.

If any articles or things supplied by the tenderer have been partially or wholly used or consumed after supply and are subsequently found to be in bad order, unsound, inferior in quality or description or are otherwise faulty or unfit for consumption/use & rusted then the contract price or prices of such articles on full will be recovered from the tenderer, if payment had already been made to him or the tenderer will not be entitled to any payment for that item & no further order will be given to him. For infringement of the stipulations of the contract or for other justifiable reasons, the contract may be terminated by the purchaser and the tenderer shall be liable for all losses sustained by the purchaser in consequence of the termination which may be recovered from the security deposit made by the tenderer or other money due or become due to him

Supply of sub-standard items or non-performance of tender terms and conditions will disqualify a firm to participate in the tender for the next five years.

### **ARBITRAIONS:**

In the event of any dispute out of the contract, such dispute should be subject to the jurisdiction of the Civil Court, Dist Nayagarh or High Court, Odisha.
