## **9. General Conditions for supply of Drugs/Chemicals & Consumables etc. :-**

a) The supplier should have minimum 10 Nos. of End User's Certificate from the concerned District authorities with 10 Nos. of order copies for last 5 years. The End user certificate should be issued by the concerned authorities of different Institution for the year's w.e.f 2014 to 2018 in the name of the Distributor and the tenderer must submit the End user's/ market standing certificate from the concerned authorities to the effect that, he supplied them Medical Drugs, Chemicals, Equipments & Instruments, BMW articles, Bedding & Clothing articles etc.

b) The supplier must submit the IT Return acknowledgement copy for last 3 years minimum.

c) The supplier must submit the audited balance sheet for last 3 years.

d) The supplier must submit the authorization certificate from the manufacturer against individual item along with valid ISO certificate.

e) The average turnover of the company should be 5 Crores each year for last 3 years.

f) At the time of supply, the supplier must submit a test report of the batches being supplied from a NABL/Govt. approved laboratory that the supplied drugs are of standard quality based on which the drugs can be used or distributed.

g) The authority will also do random testing of the supplied drugs, if required, for which quality testing, packing & forwarding charges, if any, will be borne by the supplier.

h) The supply should be made in less number of batches (less than 3) & maximum two phases and should arrive at the warehouse with remaining shelf life of at least 5/6<sup>th</sup> of the stipulated total shelf life from the date of manufacturing of that product.

i) The supply should be made in good packing condition & labeling "**ODISHA GOVT. Supply. 'NOT FOR SALE'**". MRP should not be mentioned anywhere in strip/Box/Amp/Vial etc.

j) All bills should be super-scribed "as per the subject, supply of Drugs & consumables under respective scheme" & bill should be prepared on values of the goods+ VAT/G.S.T. & then Entry Tax if applicable on Total value.


k) Sale taxes/VAT/GST will be paid extra. Entry tax, if any, should be paid by the supplying firm at the entry points which will be reimbursed to the firm along with payment for the supply on production of valid entry tax payment receipt in original attached to the bill of supplied items.

l) All bills should contain the tax payer's identification Numbers (T.I.N) so far as VAT/GST is concerned.

m) After supply all the batches of all items / Drugs will be sent for quality testing to different testing laboratories. If any batch of any item/drug comes out to be NOT OF STANDARD QUALITY (NSQ) the supplier of firm will replace the full stock of that batch no. and take back the available NSQ stock from this Health Institution at his own cost. No payment will be made for the replacement of NSQ drugs with good quality drugs.

n) If the firm/supplier doesn't replace the full stock of that batch of item declared NSQ within one month of issue of the letter, he will be derecognized for that product and no payment will be made to him for that product or if he has taken the payment for that product, the cost of that batch of NSQ drugs will be deducted from any payment due for him and no further orders will be given to him for that product. If any payment has been made to him for the said product, then the same must be refunded by the bidder within 7 days of information at their own cost.

o) Liquidated damage will be charged @ 0.5% per week beyond 30 days and up to 90 days from the date of issue of the purchase order.

**A.** Manufacturing units / Authorised dealers/ Traders are eligible to participate in the tender, provided they have :-

(iv) VAT/ GST clearance and PAN Card of the firm .(VAT/GST to be produced in appropriate form as applicable in Govt. of Odisha only The tenderer must be registered under Odisha State GST Act only.)

(v) Average turnover of Rs .05 Corers for last three years.

(vi) Valid Drug License.

(vii) Bidders who have been blacklisted either by the Tender inviting authority or by any District / state Govt. or Central Govt.
