Applications are invited in prescribed proforma from intending candidates of Odisha for filling up the following categories of posts in different Ashram Schools/ High School under ST & SC Development Department of Nayagarh District on Contractual Basis. **1. General Eligibility:**

- He/ She must be citizen of India.
- He / She must be able to speak , read and write odiya and must have passed the High school Certificate examination or Equivalent with odiya as language subject or passed Oriya test equivalent to HSC / 10<sup>th</sup> School standard conducted by the Education Department of Odisha.
- He / She must have a good character and shall submit the certificate of good character from two gazetted officers(not being his/her relation)
- He / she must not have more than one spouse living.
- A person already in service of Government shall be eligible for direct recruitment to the service subject to this being within the prescribed age limit and being otherwise eligible and subject to that he produces 'No Objection Certificates' from the competent authority at the time of verification of documents within the stipulated time before preparation of draft merit list.
- He/ She must have possessed the requisite academic and training qualification as mentioned in the coming paras.

- (g) He /She must have passed Odisha Secondary School Teachers Eligibility Test( OSSTET) for the post of TGT Arts / TGT Science (PCM)/ Sanskrit Teacher / Hindi Teacher/ PET .
- (h) Candidates possessing academic/Training qualifications from Board /Universities /Institutions outside Odisha shall have to produce the authenticated proof of equivalency, affiliation of their institutions to a recognized University and recognition of such training course and institute by NCTE, failing which he/she shall not be considered as eligible for selection.
- (i) A candidate furnishing certificates, Mark-sheets with grades and grade-points shall have to also furnish numerical equivalent of grades/grade points from the examining bodies failing which he/she shall not be treated as eligible for selection.

## 2. Age:

He /She must be below 32 years and above, 21 years of age as on 01.01.2021 provided that maximum age limit shall be relaxed by 5 years in case of candidates belongs to the ST/SC/SEBC and women candidates.

## 3. Academic and professional qualification

**(a) TGT-arts (B.A B.Ed. Teacher):-** He/she must have obtained Bachelor Degree in arts/ Commerce or a sashtri ( Sanskrit) degree with two school subjects from a recognized University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate(45% for SC/ST/OBC/SEBC candidates) along with a Degree in Bachelor Education ( B.Ed) ( a course prescribed by NCTE) from a institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

**Or,**

Four year integrated BA, B.Ed. from a NCTE recognized institutions with two school subjects are defined below have 50%marks in aggregate(45% for SC/ST/SEBC Candidates) provided that in any case the candidate must have passed Bachelor Degree with two School subjects(with not less than 200 marks each) as follows:

- i) Language subjects like English, Odiya, Sanskrit and Hindi offered as a Honours /pass /Elective /Compulsory Subject shall be treated as one school subject and,
- ii) Another subject shall be considered from the subjects like History, Geography, Economics, Political science, Indian Economy, Landmarks in Indian History, Indian Geography, Indian Polity offered as pass /Hons/Elective/Optional subject.

**(b) TGT-Science-(PCM) B.Sc B.Ed. Teacher :-** He / She must have obtained Bachelor Degree in Science (CBZ/ PCM/ from a recognized University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/OBC/SEBC candidates) along with a Degree in Bachelor Education ( a Course prescribed by NCTE) from a Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

**Or,**

Four year integrated B.Sc, B.Ed. from a NCTE recognized institution with two school subjects as defined below having 50% marks in aggregate ( 45% for SC/ST /SEBC candidates) Provided that in any case the candidates must have passed bachelor Degree with two schools subjects( with not less than 200 marks each) as follows:

For Trained Graduate Teacher- Science (PCM) : any two out of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, as elective/ Optional / Honours / Pass subjects.

**(c) Sanskrit Teacher :-** Bachelor Degree with Sanskrit as one of the elective / optional/ Honours/ pass subject from recognized University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/OBC/SEBC candidates) with Sikshya Sashtri (Sanskrit)(a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognized University / Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

**OR**

Shastri(Sanskrit) with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45%for SC/ST/OBC/SEBC candidates) recognized University and Sikshya Sashtri(Sanskrit) ( a Course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognized University / Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

**OR**

Acharya (except Jyotisha Acharya and Ayurvedaacharya) or Sahitya Acharya with minimum 50% marks in aggregate recognized University.

**OR**

Bachelor Degree with Sanskrit as one of the elective/ optional/ Honours/ Pass subject from a recognized University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/OBC/SCBC candidates) and M.A. in Sanskrit) minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized university/ Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University.

**(d) Hindi Teachers :** Bachelor Degree from a recognized University with Hindi as one of the elective/optional/Honours/ Pass subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/OBC/SEBC candidates) **or** with Rashtra Bhasha Ratna from Rastra Bhasha Pracher samiti, Vardha **or** with Sastri from Odisha Rastra Bhasa Parishad ,Puri **or** with Snatak ( Acquire by june 2005), the date upto which the temporary recognition has been granted) from Hindi Sikshya Samiti, Odisha, cuttack, **or** an equivalent Degree from recognized Institution with at least 50% marks in aggregated(45% for SC/ST/OBC/SEBC/ candidates) **AND** Hindi Sikhyan Parangat from Kendriya Hindi sansthan, Agra / B.H.Ed ( a course prescribed by NCTE) from a Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University / B.Ed in Hindi ( a course prescribed by NCTE from Dakshin Bharat Hindi Pracher Sabha, Madras and Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University)

**OR**

Bachelor Degree With Hindi as one of the optional or Honours subject with 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/OBC/SEBC candidates an M.A. in Hindi with minimum 50% marks in aggregate(45 % for SC/ST/OBC/SEBC candidates)

**(e) PET :** +2 or its equivalent examination with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/OBC/SEBC) and C.P.Ed./B.P.Ed/M.P. Ed from recognized Board/ University.

## N.B

The B.Ed./B.H. Ed./ Sikshya Sastri candidates should have registered their names either in the Employment Bureau located in Vani Vihar, Bhubaneswar/ Jyoti Vihar, Sambalpur / Bhanja Vihar, Behrampur/OUAT, Bhubaneswar or in the state Employment Exchange. The candidates for PET/ Sanskrit/ Hindi teachers should have registered their names in the Employment Exchange located in the concerned Revenue District which he/she belongs to or State Employment Exchange. SC/ST candidates should have registered their name in the special Employment Exchange for SC/ST at Bhubaneswar or in any Employment Exchange located in the concerned Revenue District which he/she belongs to.

### 4. **Reservation.**

The Odisha Reservation of Vacancies ( in posts and services for ST & SC) Act, 1975 and the Odisha Reservation of Posts & Services for Socially & Educationally Backward Classes Act, 2008 and the rules made there under and such other principles of the post based reservation as prescribed by the state Government on the land mark judgment of Hon'ble High Court/ Supreme Court, from time to time, shall be followed.

### 5. **Emoluments and Service condition :**

The emoluments and service conditions shall be guided as per the provision of G.A Deptt. Notification No. 32010 / Gen Dtd. 12.11.2013 and No. 19569 / Gen Dated 12.09.2017 & No. 19574/Ge/Dtd. 12.09.2017.

### 6. **Remuneration:-**

The contractual Teaching and Non-Teaching staff will be paid following consolidated remuneration as per Govt. in Finance Deptt. Letter No. 28090/ F, dated 22.09.2017.

### 8. **Selection Procedure :**


The selection will be made by the District Selection Committee headed by the Collector, Nayagarh, Selection shall be made only on merit i.e. on the basis of percentage of marks. After verification of certificates, Merit List (150% shall be prepared for each category of

candidates on the basis of percentage of marks secured in H.S.C Examination ( without extra optional if any),B.A/B.Com/B.Sc ( without ancillary & Foundation course if any) & B.Ed. Examination in case of Trained Graduates( Arts & Science Teacher) and in case of Sanskrit, Hindi, PET, teachers (without extra optional / Ancillary & Foundation courses if any ), the percentage of marks secured by a candidate in each qualifying examination.

- i) In case of two or more candidates secured the same marks the candidate older in age will be placed above.
- ii) If there is further tie, the higher percentage of marks secured in training qualification will be taken into account.
- iii) Higher education will not be given any weightage during preparation of merit list in all categories.
- iv) Inclusion of the names of candidates in the Merit List / Select list confers no right on the candidates to engagement unless selection committee or the appointing authority are satisfied after such enquiry or re-verification of documents as may be considered necessary, that a candidate is suitable in all respects for engagement to the service.
