

The Chief District Veterinary Officer, Nayagarh invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from Government Farms, Chick Rearing Units established under NLM, State Plan or any Central/State Government Schemes ; interested and reputed poultry birds supplier for supply of 47,385 no. of 4 weeks old unsexed LIT birds (Banaraj, Chhabro, Kuroiler, Rainbow Rooster, Kalinga Brown, RIR & other approved breeds of Government of India and 3950 no. of 02 weeks old unsexed ducklings (Khaki Campbell/Indian Runner) to the beneficiaries selected under the state plan scheme "Livelihood Support to farmers through "Rural Backyard Poultry Rearing" and "Rural Backyard duckery Rearing" respectively for the year 2024-25 of different 08 blocks of Nayagarh District under the following terms and conditions.

1. Birds will be supplied at Block Headquarters V.D/2nd V.D/LAC point of Nayagarh District in consultation with DD/BVO at the time of delivery.
2. 45 numbers of live good quality birds will be handed over to each beneficiary through DD/BVO/AVAS of concerned block in two phases (25+20) with an interval of 02 months and 50 number of ducklings will be handed over to each concern beneficiary in two phases (25+25) with an interval of 02 months.
3. The birds should be healthy and disease free at the time of delivery and must have been covered with at least three vaccines i.e. F₁ & booster and IBD .
4. Transit mortality will be borne by the supplier.
5. The cost of 04 weeks old poultry bird should never exceed Rs. 72.00 and cost of ducklings should never exceed Rs. 75.00 (inclusive of both packing & transportation).
6. The minimum weight of bird will not be less than 200 grams on the date of supply.
7. Certificate on source of procurement of birds and vaccination of birds to be produced by the supplier before the concerned DD/BVO at the time of supply.
8. The route chart should be shared to DD/BVOs prior to delivery of birds (minimum 03 days before)
9. Preference will be given to the suppliers who have previous experiences.
10. Birds will be received by the beneficiaries approved by block level committee through the AVAS/BVO/D.D. of concerned block.
11. Bills will be raised in favour of CDVO, Nayagarh through BVO/D.D. of concerned block.
12. Payment will be made by CDVO, Nayagarh on receipt of quality and quantity certificate by concerned BVO/D.D.
13. The last date for receiving application is 23.12.2024.
14. The authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all application without assigning any reason thereof.
15. A registered farm having GST along with own breeding farm/hatchery and CRU will be preferred. All relevant papers in support of their claim of EOI and an undertaking regarding the period from placing of order by CDVO, Nayagarh within which the bird supply will be completed must be submitted for consideration.
16. EOIs received if incomplete or after the scheduled date and time will not be entertained.
17. After receipt of the EOIs from the interested providers, one market survey will be conducted by a joint team of officers under CDVO, Nayagarh on dt. 24.12.2024 at 10AM for finalization of successful service provider to whom the work will be assigned.


